MEANING OF MORAL DEVELOPMENT

MORAL DEVELOPMENT IS THE PROCESS IN WHICH THE CHILD ACQUIRES THE VALUES ESTEEMED BY HIS COMMUNITY.... ACQUIRES A SENSE OF RIGHT AND WRONG IN TERMS OF THESE VALUES LEARNS TO REGULATE HIS PERSONAL DESIRES AND COMPULSIONS SO THAT, WHEN A SITUATIONAL CONFLICT ARISES HE DOES WHAT HE OUGHT TO DO RATHER THAN WHAT HE WANTS TO DO MORAL DEVELOPMENT IS THE PROCESS BY WHICH A COMMUNITY SEEKS TO TRANSFER THE EGO-CENTRICITY OF THE BABY INTO THE SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR OF THE MATURE ADULT.



LEVEL OF MORAL DEVELOPMENT

- PRE CONVENTIONAL LEVEL (4 TO 10 YEARS)
- CONVENTIONAL LEVEL (10 TO 13 YEARS)
- POST CONVENTIONAL LEVEL (13 AND ABOVE)

- PUNISHMENT AND OBEDIENCE ORIENTATION
- INSTRUMENTAL RELATIVIST ORIENTATION

- GOOD BOY/GIRL ORIENTATION
- LAW AND ORDER ORIENTATION

- SOCIAL CONTACT ORIENTATION
- UNIVERSAL ETHICAL PRINCIPLES ORIENTATION
